DELIBERATE DISCIPLESHIP

- Following Jesus has cost and consequences it can isolate and separate us from those not likewise dedicated to Him.
- Discipleship requires that Jesus be the first love, and it requires renunciation of anything that comes before Him.
- Discipleship is a full-time commitment, and nothing should modify, interrupt, or compete with it.
- Faith does not stop with decision, it commences. Faith is the entry into relationship.
- True discipleship = Dying to Live!
