Powerful Promise

"I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high." (Luke 24:48-49)

⁴While he was with them, he commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for the Father's promise. "Which," he said, "you have heard me speak about; ⁵for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit in a few days." (Acts 1:4-5)

Misunderstood

⁶So when they had come together, they asked him, "Lord, are you restoring the kingdom to Israel at this time?" (Act 1:6)

- ➤ The disciples are still confused about Jesus' ministry, expecting Him to overthrow Rome.
- > They were concerned about those with political power over them.
- > Jesus tells them about a much greater power, which they were about to receive.

Power

Witnesses

Matures (mar-toos) in the Greek means to be a witness (literally, judicially or figuratively).

It calls to mind one who bears "witness" to what he has seen or heard or knows.

The Book of Acts records the spread of the gospel in Jerusalem and to Judea, Samaria, Europe, Africa and Asia.

Epilogue

⁹After he had said this, he was taken up as they were watching, and a cloud took him out of their sight. ¹⁰While he was going, they were gazing into heaven, and suddenly two men in white clothes stood by them. ¹¹They said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking up into heaven? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come in the same way that you have seen him going into heaven." (Act 1:9-11)



Internally Powered

- Created for the same purpose to transfer power
- Designed for different applications, different tasks
- > External power source, internal storage
- Dysfunctional without power
- Worthless unless used
- Dangerous if misused



INpowered

- Come in different shapes & sizes don't look alike
- Created for a purpose to make disciples
- Uniquely designed and equipped for the task
- > Internally powered we can do nothing on our own
- > Some are fully charged, and some are dead
- Some remain in the original wrapper, unused
