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



- ➤ Two disciples recognized Him on the road to Emmaus (John 24:31)
- ➤ Five hundred people recognized Him in one gathering (1 Cor. 15:6)
- ➤ Even doubting Thomas finally recognized Him (John 20:24-29)

ETERNAL MARRIAGE

REVELATION 19:6-9

⁶Then I heard something like the voice of a vast multitude, like the sound of cascading waters, and like the rumbling of loud thunder, saying, Hallelujah, because our Lord God, the Almighty, reigns! ⁷Let us be glad, rejoice, and give him glory, because **the marriage of the Lamb has come, and his bride has prepared herself.** ⁸She was given fine linen to wear, bright and pure. For the fine linen represents the righteous acts of the saints. ⁹Then he said to me, "Write: Blessed are those invited to **the marriage feast of the Lamb!**"

MARRIAGE

FIRST CENTURY
CUSTOMS

Ancient Wedding Customs:

1. The Engagement/Betrothal: a contract was signed by the parents of the bride and the groom with a dowry paid.



2. The Wedding: Usually a year later, the groom went to the house of the bride at midnight. The bride would know in advance this was going to happen and she would be ready. They would end up at the groom's home.



3. The Marriage Supper: The feast following the wedding might go on for days, as illustrated by the wedding at Cana in John 2:1–2.
